

Herve B. Lemaire Award For Excellence in Education

This annual award recognizes a teacher, coach, or administrator who has had an extraordinary impact on Natick students. To qualify for selection, a nominee must have served for a minimum of 5 years in any public school in Natick.

The Award is named in memory of Herve B. Lemaire, to honor and exemplify his exceptional commitment to the quality of education in Natick Public Schools. Mr. Lemaire served as a French and Latin teacher before becoming vice principal, then principal of Wilson Junior High School. He served as principal from 1966 until his retirement in 1986. Under his tenure as principal, in a ceremony at The White House, Wilson was recognized as one of the top one hundred schools in the United States.
