June Meeting Minutes approved.

Update provided on the three issues that NTY voted on in June:

- 1) Tilly and Salvy's liquor license request -some sale of items restrictions were put in place. Now in front of the state licensing board for approval.
- 2) Serving alcohol in public school buildings during adult events-Selectmen and School Committee hope to take this up in a joint meeting.
- 3) Our financial contribution to MAPA-was agreed on.

Our need to vote on issues in June brought up the need for having official by-laws to govern NTY's structure and voting process.

A Leadership Team will be formed (all interested members welcome) to begin drafting a process for determining the structure and by-laws of NTY. First meeting of Leadership Team scheduled for September 13th. Sign up will be through "doodle".

NTY has worked with Natick Public Schools to have AlcoholEdu provided to students and parents at NHS for the next three years.

Four students were referred for diversion at Natick High School

Librarians will be reading "The Red Ribbon, A Story of Hope" to fourth grade students in Natick elementary schools in October during Red Ribbon and Substance Abuse Prevention Month. NTY is introducing the Red Ribbon book to teach students that when a community works together and each person gives a little and uses their skills and talents, more people can get what they need. (sharing resources)

Margaret Boudreau, Sandy Pease and Jane Detwiler shared their experience from the CADCA week of training that they each attended in Feb, April and August 2012 respectively.

NTY hopes to launch its' new website by the end of September. Safe Home Pledge will be prominent feature on new website.

The October Coalition Meeting will be our Annual Retreat and preparations are underway for it to be an hands-on experience that will "Move us into Action"!

Everyone was emailed a "Coalition Exercise" in advance of this meeting and copies were provided at today's meeting. All Coalition members are encouraged to complete the exercise so that we can build on those responses at the Retreat and begin to draft our Action Plan for Year 2.
