Medicinal Marijuana Updates:

1. The law has gone into effect and DPH has 120 days to write the regulations that will in part determine how much is a 60 day supply. No licenses will be issued until the regulations are provided to communities.
2. There is a new movement to create a "third way" project on marijuana that is an alternative between legalization and the current status of marijuana. After many months of work on a national level, this third alternative has evolved into **Project SAM - Smart Approaches to Marijuana**. SAM will be a bipartisan group, chaired by Rep. Patrick J. Kennedy, Jr., and will include George W. Bush's former speechwriter and Newsweek/Daily Beast columnist David Frum, Harvard Professor Sharon Levy, and other public health professionals and lawmakers.
